

Texas State University School of Nursing Fees and Supplies

Clinical supplies:

- Blood pressure cuff
- Stethoscope and ID tag
- Bandage scissors
- Kelly forceps (hemostat)

Nursing students are responsible for the above supplies; they can be purchased at Uniform Destination, retailers and/or on-line.

Tuition:

Nursing students do not pay the following fees with their tuition:

- Bus and recreational sports
- Student Center
- Medical – Student Health Center

Plan A.

If you are in the Central Texas area - purchase your scrubs (2 sets) at Uniform Destination at the Round Rock outlet store.

Tell the clerk that you are a Texas State University nursing student and then you will be shown the styles available to you. Select your styles, pay for them and then request that the "Texas State University logo" be embroidered onto the scrub top. Scrubs ordered in the store may not be available immediately for pick up.

Purchase your scrubs on site from Uniform Destination (Round Rock) during New Student Orientation, August 18 and 19, 2011. They accept a debit card or the following credit cards:

Lab Coat

The cost of the lab coat about \$20 and you only need one. Purchase your lab coat from Uniform Destination at the Round Rock Outlet Mall.

Plan A.
